For Education as a whole, the last few years have been challenging ones. Across all levels of education there have been funding cuts, new regulations, and in Primary Schools a new national curriculum and ways of assessing. But with challenges come opportunities. Fieldhead Carr and the way in which they have responded positively to these challenges and worked towards the best outcomes for our children. General Information



School Building

Our school is quietly located in the outer area of East Leeds. The original school building, which opened in 1975, is spacious and maintained to a high standard, providing excellent areas for children to learn and develop. We are fortunate to have larger than average classrooms and a number of shared spaces for the children to access. Our range of excellent facilities include extensive playing fields, well equipped playgrounds, an ICT suite with the most up to date technology and a separate dining area with an outdoor space for warm weather days.

Due to the increasingly high demand for places at our school, preparations are underway for a 2 storey extension taking us to a two form entry, 60 child cohort from September 2018.

The project is hugely exciting for us as it promises to provide a state-of-the-art facility for our children.

Admission Arrangements

Main School

Admission arrangements into Reception classes in community primary schools in Leeds are arranged by the Local Authority. A booklet called 'Starting School in Leeds' setting out the admissions procedures and criteria, together with details of how to apply, are available from the School Admissions team at Leeds County Council. Our school office team is always on hand to support you with this process should you need further advice.

Parents and Carers of children seeking to join the school in other year groups, should contact the office and request an in year common transfer form.

Nursery

Children can start Nursery from their third birthday, if a space is available, accessing morning or afternoon sessions. This offer can be taken up using the government's 'free 15 hours' initiative. Additional morning or afternoon sessions can also be booked at a daily cost, allowing your child to attend from 8.45 until 3.15pm up to 5 days per week.

Fieldhead Carr Primary welcomes all children regardless of special needs or disability. We pride ourselves on the nurturing nature of our school. Pupils with additional needs may have extra visits before starting school and there will be close liaison with parents to ensure that the correct arrangements are in place.

Moving on

Our Upper Key Stage 2 staff and the Pastoral team are very experienced and highly skilled at supporting both parents and children through the secondary transition process. They work closely with the secondary pastoral teams to ensure a smooth transition that meets the needs of the individual pupil. Children from Fieldhead Carr are renowned for their smooth transition into the secondary system due to the quality of the preparation they have received.

There is a large variety of secondary schools we feed into, so families have a huge choice on offer.



Curriculum

We are proud to say that our curriculum is personalised and tailor made to suit the needs of our school community

We have taken the most successful, innovative and pioneering educational practices and shaped them into a curriculum that promotes high quality, realistic experiences for our children.



Our children's maths lessons are based upon the leading practices from around the world. We have adopted an investigative approach to our numeracy learning, giving children the opportunity to take ownership of their own learning.

Literacy lessons allow our children to hone their reading and writing skills through immersion in their class novel. Their classrooms are themed to support this and their work is carefully planned for engaging and realistic opportunities. This approach allows not only for the development of technical skills but high levels of enjoyment and creativity.

We have adopted a cross curricular approach to our foundation subjects, making ours a very 'Creative Curriculum'. Lessons are enriched with interactive and innovative activities through which key skills are taught. We carefully tailor these in order to meet the needs of all our children and the diversity of our community.



Extra Curricular



We are thrilled to offer an excellent and varied range of extra-curricular activities outside of the classroom from football to choir, dance and karate. Our clubs are taught by both school staff and by external companies. Activities change throughout the year to offer a diverse experience for the children and to ensure the clubs we have on offer are of the highest quality.

We are also very proud of our University for Children. Our aim is that we inspire children to become curious learners outside of the curriculum and outside of school. University for Children is a whole school initiative that runs during the school day to ensure that ALL of our children are able to attend. Staff 'pitch' their exciting and inspiring courses to the children who then apply to attend for a term. Each term sees something new and exciting. In the past we have had clubs such as ballet, yoga, chess, Harry Potter, boxing, rugby, animation, cookery and lots more. At the end of the school year all of the children graduate from university with a full ceremony.



Childcare Provision

At Fieldhead Carr we are proud to be one of the leading providers of wrap around childcare in the local area. Our service ensures that our working families are fully supported and the children are happy in a nurturing, fun and safe environment. Children are welcome in our school club from the age of 3. The service begins before school at 7.45am and runs after school until 6pm. Full days are also available during most school holidays, alongside externally run sport and holiday clubs.

Community Links

We are a small school with a big heart; a welcoming hub to all members of our community.

We strongly believe that it takes a whole community to raise a child and each member matters to our school family. Our building is a 'home' to a range of activities for the community and we welcome visitors.

We take pride in our excellent relationships with all stakeholders. Parents play an essential role in the day to day life of the school and this is underpinned by a solid home school learning partnership. Not only has this, but our Friends of Fieldhead Carr (PTA) organise events throughout the year which are extremely popular within our school and the wider community. These range from discos to fireworks displays, family photo days and fayres. Proceeds of all our events go towards enriching and enhancing our children's educational experience.

Our big heart extends even further afield, reaching locations across Leeds and even around the world via our charity work. From singing to the elderly, food drives for the homeless and sponsoring a child in Africa through Action Aid, we are proud of our contribution to those in need.
